One Championship will be organised, grouping all categories (men, mixed and women crews). This event is open to all crews originating from Europe or from a nation of the Mediterranean Basin having a National 470 Class Association, without limitation of entries per nation, and to crews from other nations invited by the International 470 Class Association on a case-by-case basis. All participating crews shall be in good standing with the International 470 Class Association (good standing means in particular that the corresponding National Associations have paid their annual fees for 2004 before end of February 2005) and with the Organising Committee (good standing means in particular that they comply with the ISAF Eligibility Code). **Each crew member shall not attain her or his 22nd birthday before 31st December 2005** (i.e.born in 1984 or later).

According to our regulations, the titles of "470 Class Junior European Champion" and of "470 Class Women's Junior European Champion" will be awarded respectively to the first crew and to the first women crew of the Championship, originating from Europe or from a nation of the Mediterranean Basin having a National 470 Class Association.

The notice of race and the entry form will be issued soon and available at the Organiser Website and at the International 470 Class Association Website (www.470.org). Entries will be Web-based only via www.470.org.
